Curriculum Information

English

In Writing, we are going to delve into the world of the book Seal Surfer and in Autumn 2 Winter's Child. These are imaginative and unique books, which promote equality. We will develop a rich vocabulary as we work towards writing a letter and towards Christmas, our own fantasy story.

Maths

In Maths, we are covering place value, addition & subtraction and multiplication & division. This will form the basis 4 operations knowledge needed to be able to cover the rest of the year 3 curriculum later in the year.

Science

In Science, we are going to explore Animals including Humans. We will focus on animal diets, nutrition and the function of skeletons.

Topic

In Geography, we will be developing our knowledge about the UK. We will use maps and globes to locate countries, counties and cities within the UK. We will also explore famous European landmarks and compare life in Leeds to living in Spain.

Art / Design Technology

In Art, we will be experimenting with pencils for sketching and adding different tones/textures. In DT, we will be baking microwave muffins.

Computing

In Computing, we will be focusing on how information is moved between devices to form a network. We will also use stop frame animation to create a motion storyboard. **PE**

In Spanish, Year 3 will start learning all about Spanish speaking countries. They will learn how to introduce themselves and count to 10. Year 3 will then move on to learn about animals and how to use the correct article.

In PSHE, we will learn how to celebrate differences, what bullying is, how to manage challenges and how we spend and save money.

Music will focus on composition, performance and appraisal.
