Curriculum Information

English In English, we will develop children's grammar skills within every English lesson. Children will re-tell stories, debate orally, read and write poetry this term. Children will also take part in daily spelling sessions tailored to their own spelling level.

Maths This term in Maths, our key learning will include work on multiplication and division, length and perimeter, fractions and decimals. Number and calculation skills will continue to be a focus of Maths lessons and Early bird morning Maths.

Science We will be learning all about living things and their habitats this half-term. We will look at animal and plant food chains; learning about how local environmental changes have impacted these. We will be taking a school trip to Skelton Grange Environment Centre to embrace outdoor learning! Next half-term, we will be learning about states of matter. We will be exploring the various processes of water and other liquids changing into solid, liquid and gas form.

Topic This term, our Geography-focused topic will be 'Mountains'. We will learn about the world's famous mountains with a particular focus on Mount Everest. We will also look at how fold mountains and volcanoes are formed as well as developing map reading skills.

Art / Design Technology In DT we will be designing and making our own sandwiches! We will start off by testing different breads to decide which we enjoy best. We will learn how to prepare the sandwich ingredients and handle food safely.

Computing – we will learn how to edit a photograph and record a podcast.

Music / PSHE / RE In Music, children will continue with the activities from the Charanga music school. This term's focus songs will be 'Stop bullying!', focusing on rap, rhythm and volume.

Our topic this half term in PHSE is playing safe. We will learn about road, rail and water safety and have a visitor coming in from the canals and rivers trust.

This term in RE children will be learning how the 5 pillars of Islam help Muslims to lead a good life.
