Curriculum Information

English

In Writing, we will be focusing on non-fiction texts linked to our class book *The Big Blue Whale*. Pupils will develop their knowledge of non-fiction features, build subject-specific vocabulary, and write their own informative pieces.

Maths

In Maths, we will cover fractions, money, time, shape and statistics. Pupils will develop their problem-solving and reasoning skills alongside building fluency and confidence in key concepts.

Science

In Science, we will be learning about light. Pupils will explore how light travels, how shadows are formed, and investigate reflective materials through practical enquiries.

Topic

In History, we are studying Ancient Egypt. Pupils will learn about daily life, significant achievements, and key historical figures, developing their understanding of how this civilisation has influenced the modern world.

Art / Design Technology

In Art, pupils will create Egyptian-inspired artwork, exploring pattern, colour and symbolism. They will develop their skills in drawing and design.

Computing

In Computing, pupils will learn programming skills by creating and sequencing events using Scratch. They will develop their understanding of algorithms, debugging and logical thinking.

PE

In PE, pupils will take part in orienteering and athletics, developing teamwork, coordination, stamina and problem-solving skills through a range of physical activities.

Music / PSHE / Spanish / RE

In RE, pupils will explore Creation Stories and consider different beliefs about how the world began. In PSHE, we will focus on careers, finance and physical health. In Spanish, pupils will learn vocabulary linked to fruit and ice cream. In Music, pupils will develop their skills in listening, composing and reflecting on different pieces of music.

Additional Information
